

Materials:

Yarn of your choice. (I used cotton)

Crochet hook G6

Elastic cord.

Cute buttons.

Small amount of felt.

Ch 13

Sc in 2nd chain from hook and across. When you get to the end, begin crocheting on the opposite side of your chain. You will have a total of 24 sc. Place a stitch marker in the next stitch and crochet in each sc around until your pouch measures about 5 inches. (or as tall as you want it)

For the flap:

ch 1, turn, sc in next 11 sc.

ch1, turn, sc in next 11 sc (5 more times)

ch1 ,turn slip stitch in each sc across and down the sides of your flap, all the way around your pouch until you get back to your first slip stitch. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Make a little loop with your elastic and hot glue the ends together. Cut a small piece of felt and glue it to the inside of your flap, leaving your elastic loop sticking out of the top.



Last of all, sew on a really cute button and your done.
